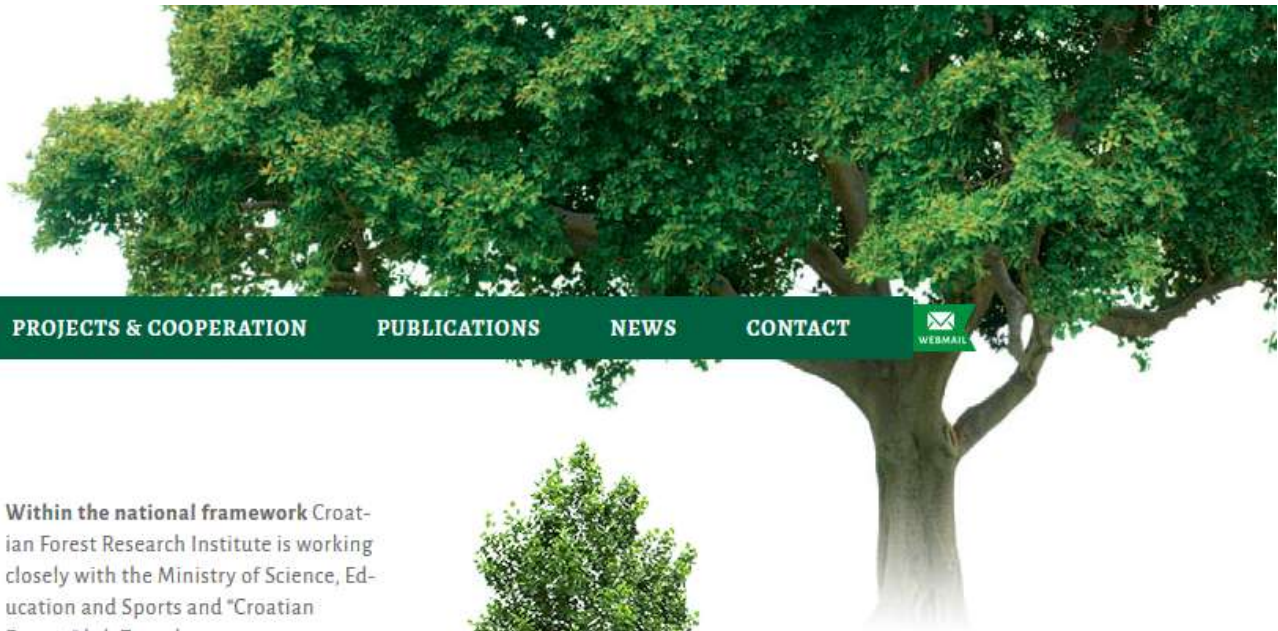

## About EFISEE

EFISEE Regional office is a unit of the European Forest Institute which focuses its activities in South-East Europe. The office was launched in July 2012 with the support of the 9 forest research and education partner institutions in South-Eastern Europe.

EFISEE is conducting research, networking, information and advocacy for forestry in the SEE region with strong science-policy interface. These activities facilitate decision making processes by linking stakeholders to forestry issues in South-East Europe.

### Donors

EFISEE is being hosted by the Croatian forest research institute, in Jastrebarsko, and is funded by the Ministry of Science, Education and Sports and the Ministry Agriculture.

Mediterranean Regional Office - EFIMED, located in Barcelona, Spain.



The first EF Regional Office, the Mediterranean Regional Office EFIMED, was established in July 2007 as a pilot. Atlantic European Regional Office - EFATLANTIC, located in Bordeaux, France



EFATLANTIC covers the region of the Atlantic Rim, and was launched in spring 2008. Its general focus is the sustainable management and use/pasture utilization of planted forest resources. Central East and South-East European Regional Office - EFICEEC EFISEE, located in Vienna, Austria and Zagreb, Croatia



EFICEEC covers a region extending from the Baltic Countries down to South Eastern Europe, and was launched in April 2010. EFICEEC has three broad Work Areas: forest under policy and economics; land use change in the context of climate change and bio-energy; and forest ecosystem management.

In 2012, EF signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Croatian Forest Research Institute starting at the establishment of the South-East European Regional Office, EFISEE. For the first two years, EFISEE will operate jointly with EFICEEC. Its focus is on South-East European activities with its partnering organisations.

North European Regional Office - EFINDRO, located in Umeå, Sweden



EFINDRO covers the Nordic countries and the countries in the Baltic Sea region and the North Atlantic region, and launched its activities in April 2010. The two thematic issues of EFINDRO are biomass production and ecosystem services, with cross-cutting themes of climate change, environmental economics and governance and policy. Central European Regional Office - EFICENT, located in Freiburg, Germany



EFICENT ran from 2009 until the end of 2016. It aimed to promote and support national, transboundary and European-wide collaboration in research and information provision, and strengthen networking in the Central European region. General topics with regional focus included changing resource availability and multifunctional demands towards forests. An officer of Ferdinand I of Habsburg's troops deployed in Croatian forts in defense against the invasion of the Ottoman Empire under Suleiman I, advancing towards Vienna. Between 1522 and 1526.

In 1532, Captain Nikola Jurišić defended the small border fort of Kőszeg (Kingdom of Hungary) with only 700–800 Croatian soldiers with no cannons and few guns, preventing the advance of the Turkish army of 120,000–140,000 toward Vienna
